I had the privilege of traveling to Montana with several pastors from across Missouri with a team from the Missouri Baptist Convention's Missions Mobilization in May. We went to connect with pastors from the Montana SBC to explore possible future mission opportunities for our churches. In the middle of all the beauty of the state of Montana we found such lostness that had a foreign mission field feeling. In fact, we were told that up to 93% of Montana is unsaved. Why was my question!

Here are a few of the answers we were given:

-Montana is more "pre-Christian" than "post-Christian". Most people that I know don't have a Christian in their family lineage.

-There's a rugged independence here. A "pick yourself up by the bootstraps" kind of place. That can create a difficult place to reach people who need Christ.

-There is the rich and the poor with little or no in between. The rich are literally unreachable (actual no access to them) and the poor have to be reached by meeting physical needs before they will listen to the Gospel (which is taxing on small congregations).

I came away from the trip with a burden for these pastors and their families as they work tirelessly to reach their communities. I also came away with a renewed zeal for Acts 1:8!

Acts 1:8 - But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

God could have sent a host of angels to proclaim salvation from the highest mountains. He could have written His saving message across the sky with the clouds. He could have sent fire, or shouted out the Good News with thunder from Heaven. But He chose US to be witnesses! That is His plan! That is His plan for Montana AND Missouri; in fact, for all the world!
